Outside Creative Fun

While the weather is nice, why not try these fun activities to get more creative outside.

Colourful water gun/spray bottle painting - You will need:

- * water gun or spray bottles * paper * watered down paint
- * somewhere to hang the paper.

- Hang the paper up
- Fill the gun or bottle with the watered down paint
- Have lots of fun creating different pictures

Squirty Chalk - You will need:

- * corn flour * food colouring * water * squirt bottles * bicarbonate of soda * vinegar

- Fill up the squirt bottle roughly 2/3 of the way with the corn flour and bicarbonate of soda (roughly the same amount of each)
- Add a few drops of food colouring
- Fill up the rest of the bottle with water, you may need a knife to help stir, the mixture will be very thick at first. After you have mixed it, place the caps on the bottle and shake them before use.
- Fill an empty squirt bottle with vinegar and watch what happens to your chalk pictures when you add the vinegar.
